The Lloyd Wright Collection is a distinctive brick format inspired by the acclaimed architecture of Frank Lloyd Wright.

The Collection is based on the thin roman brick which has been re-engineered by Brikmakers to have a unit size of $290 \times 90 \times 47$ mm, making it suitable for conventional brick coursing.

Frank Lloyd Wright, as most design and building industry professionals well know, was the American architect, writer, interior designer and educator whose innovative and original offices, churches, schools, homes, skyscrapers, hotels and museums still influence the work of many contemporary design and construction leaders around the world.

As a child, the young Wright spent many hours playing with the Fröebel blocks his mother had bought the family.

The distinctive geometrical clarity evident in so many of his buildings is attributed to this childhood experimentation.

And his always innovative use of Roman-style thin bricks is legendary.

Lloyd Wright is famous for his use of bold, cantilevered balconies and is arguably the originator of the 'open plan' approach to interior design, among several other now popular innovations.

Frank Lloyd Wright's work provides a cornerstone, if not the foundation, of architectural modernism and Brikmakers is proud to be helping his timeless style and simplicity to become an impressive and permanent part of Australia's architectural landscape.


